3.2	TYPE OF TOLLS AND APPLICATION PRINCIPLES (Article 6.b of Decision 2009/750/EC)	Open tolling system by imposition of a specific toll fee per vehicle category, regardless of the distance traveled. The toll fee must not exceed the Maximum Conventional Toll Rate Limit defined in the Concession Agreement (Article 25.2), subject to annual indexation (Article 25.3.1). Toll fees are also subject to the current Value Added Tax based on the Greek Law is added. The toll stations are along the motorway (6 Frontal and 7 Ramp Toll Stations). The electronic lanes are equipped with a barrier that opens only if the transponder has an adequate cash balance.
3.3	VEHICLES SUBJECT TO TOLLS (Article 6.c of Decision 2009/750/EC)	All the vehicles entering the motorway are obliged to pay toll fees except for the following categories that are specified in the Concession Agreement (Article 25.4): i.
